

Earlier today the Formentera Council Office of Tourism handed out certificates and commemorative plaques to participants of the administration's programme to measure and promote quality tourism services. Twenty-eight businesses providing either goods or services to tourists received the distinction known as SICTED (Sistema Integral de Qualitat Turística en Destinació). Two new member businesses signed on to the programme in 2015, while the remaining 26 have renewed their memberships.

As tourism councillor Alejandra Ferrer pointed out, the CiF has relied on the SICTED system of quality assurance since 2009. "The Council is thrilled to see the work these companies have put in," she said, "because it is a sign of their commitment to providing constantly improving services, year after year."
