On 1 December, the Formentera Office of Social Welfare (*Conselleria de Benestar Social, CBS*) will host a new course on responsible alcohol distribution and risk reduction for individuals working at music and dance establishments, particularly bar staff and mangers. The free course takes place in one session, 4.00pm to 6.00pm, in the CBS training room, located in the Formentera Day Centre.

This course, the fourth of its kind this year, is part of the Consell de Formentera-backed Don't Drown in Alcohol (*No t'ofeguis en l'alcohol*) campaign, which enjoys the collaboration of Salut i Comunitat, the local small- and medium-sized business group ( *PIMEF* 

), the Chamber of Commerce and the Hotel Federation.

The course is designed to equip participants with information to make music and dance spaces safer and increase patrons' sense of well-being.
