



APNEEF, in association with the Consell de Formentera, City Council of Santa Eulària des Riu, Palau de Congressos and Rafa Cavestany, are back on Formentera and Eivissa with a new programme of classical music concerts featuring Camerata Deià Piano Quartet and Alfredo Oyagüez.

Pianist Alfredo Oyagüez joins Camerata Deià Piano Quartet's violinist, violist and cellist as they present audiences with year-two of artists' celebration of one hundred years since the birth of Argentine composer Astor Piazzolla. The crowd will also enjoy works by violinist Fritz Kreisler and famous Austrian composer Joseph Haydn.

The first concert starts at 8.00pm in Santa Eulària des Riu's Palau de Congressos on Friday 8 October. The second concert will take shape from 8.30pm Saturday 9 October in Formentera's Sala de Cultura (Cinema). Per safety Covid-19 protocols, the show will have limited seating.
