

The postboxes installed last year by the Formentera Council at the Casa del Poble in La Mola and at the old primary school in Es Cap de Barbaria are currently being used by 140 Formentera homes.

Following the cessation of door-to-door mail delivery, the service was conceived as a way to prevent residents living in remote dwellings from having to inquire in person at the post offices of the island to receive their mail.

So far, the service has been solicited by one hundred homes located in the communities of Es Monestir and Sa Talaiassa in La Mola and by forty families in Es Cap.

At present, the Formentera Council is studying the possibility of extending post office box service to residents of the Cala Saona and Es Pi des Català communities. Applications are available at the Citizen Information Office (I'OAC).
