

On Thursday 10 June, Centre Antoni Tur 'Gabrielet' welcomes Sandra Lorinquer and Muntsa Darné as the pair of artists pull back the curtain on a collaborative exhibition titled "Poetic break". The show's roots go back to May 2020. That's when the creative duo began work on what, nearly a year later, looked like a book. But when Lorinquer, a poet, and Darné, a photographer, unveil their work's most recent incarnation today, it is "Poetic break" the exhibition. In three languages, French (Lorinquer's native tongue), English and Castilian Spanish, at the centre of the project are 24 poems which relate the thoughts and encounters that accompany years of travels and experiences. All the while, Darné's 20 photographs offer interpretations of Lorinquer's poems, adding a visual layer to the emotions inhabiting the text.

The show is on view 11.00am to 2.00pm and 5.00pm to 8.00pm, every day except Wednesdays and Sundays until 19 June.
