The Formentera Office of Culture is pleased to report that from 27 September to 8 October, Sala d'Exposicions "Ajuntament Vell" will host Yolanda Costa's "Raíces".

The exhibition is composed of a series of paintings of varying formats and sizes, which seek connection with the natural space that surrounds us.
